### 17. Albert Bichot Hautes Cotes de Nuits Blanc (Chardonnay) 2020 Burgundy, France

*The predominant white flower and citrus nose leads to notes of honey and dried fruit. The palate is very well balanced, skillfully blending vivacity and roundness*

### 18. L'Ptit Paysan Chardonnay 2018 Monterey, California

*Tight and brisk aromas of lemon peel and sandstone come through on the nose. It's soft on the palate in texture, but a wet stone minerality and lemon juice acidity provide tension, with dried pear and orange peel flavors showing as well*

### 19. Stephane Ogier Condrieu (Viognier) 2016 Northern Rhone, France

*Barrel fermented. Medium bodied with quite opulent aromas of white peach and dried apricots. Fresh acidity leads to a very long finish.*

### 20. Gerard Bertrand 'Cotes de Roses' Rosé 2020 Languedoc, France

*The bouquet releases aromas of summer fruits, cassis and redcurrant. Floral notes of rose along with hints of grapefruit complete the picture.*

### 21. Greywacke 2021 Marlborough, New Zealand

*This stunning white is aromatic, fresh and intense, with notes of lemon curd, yuzu, peach, ripe melon and honeysuckle that are effortless and mouthwatering.*

### 22. Pahlmeyer Chardonnay 2018 Napa Valley, California

*Generous aromas of Meyer lemon curd, citron, toasted brioche and hints of delicate white florals. The palate offers richness up front and on the long finish, with mouthwatering mid-palate acidity and flinty wet stone characteristics giving the wine attractive depth and substantial texture*

### 23. Cedeberg Sauvignon Blanc 2020 South Africa

*An aromatic Sauvignon Blanc with a combination of tropical, citrus and green aromas. Aromas of gooseberries, guava, lemon zest with hints of asparagus and green fig*

## ON TAP RED WINES

### 1. Kenefick Ranch 'Chris's Cuvee' Cabernet Sauvignon 2017 Calistoga, Napa Valley, California

*Fine tobacco leaf, baker's chocolate, and a brooding dark fruit profile form an intense nose. Racy acidity and balanced tannin to oak ratios support the jammy and refined fresh berry profile.*

### 2. La Crema Pinot Noir 2021 Sonoma Coast, California

*Aromas of blackberry, cherry, leather, and tobacco with flavors of red cherry, raspberry, and boysenberry. Subtle hints of espresso and cocoa nib underpin notes of exotic spice and toast..*

### 3. La Marea Grenache 2019 Central Coast, California

*The color is extremely pale ruby with clean ripe aromas of both black and red cherry.*

*Notes of sarsaparilla and a delicate restrained earthy quality*

### 4. Bedrock Zinfandel 2020 Lodi, California

*A briar patch of a wine, with zesty wild berry, underbrush and licorice*

*flavors that finish with medium-grained tannins.*

### 5. Harvey & Harriet Red Blend 2019 Paso Robles, California

*Cabernet, Syrah, Petite Sirah blend. Aromas of Bing cherry, red raspberry, blueberries, roasted rhubarb, cardamom, and brown sugar. On the palate, pleasing sensations of vanilla and spice give way to grilled meats, olive tapenade, cedar, and molasses.*

### 6. Joseph Gevrey Chambertin (Pinot Noir) 2019 Burgundy, France

*A beautiful, bright ruby color. Intensely fruity on the nose, the aromas are reminiscent of black cherry, wild blackberry and licorice. The woody character is subtle and marries delicately with the other aromas.*

### 7. Cambria Syrah 2016 Santa Maria Valley, California

*The wine has a deep purple color with concentrated flavors of raspberry and blackberry as well as aromas of cured meat and mocha.*

### 8. Hourglass 'HGIII' Red Blend (Merlot, Petit Sirah, Cabernet Sauvignon) 2019 Napa Valley, California

*With red and black currant forming the aromatic core, dried herb and fennel are their verdant, savory counterpart. A ripe juicy frame of dark sour and red cherry mingles with inky black cassis laced with fine streaks of dark Belgian chocolate.*

### 9. Synthesi Aglianico del Vulture 2017 Vulture, Basilicata, Italy

*Concentrated dark-fruit nose with nutty overtones of oak and hints of vanilla. Lush dark fruit with enough acidity to balance it and fine long tannins.*

### 10. De Stefani 'Soler' Rosso 2019 Veneto, Italy

*Deep ruby color, intense scents of ripe fruit, prunes, violet, with ethereal and spicy notes; full body, very important structure, with layers of silky tannins and a complex bouquet. Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere, Refosco and Marzemino blend*

### 11. Domaine de la Conseillere Julienas 2016 Beujolais, France

*Color: Clean dark red ruby color and a nice brilliance. Nose: Fresh fruity on the nose and characteristic flower aromas of peony and ripe red fruits (wild-strawberries, red-current and raspberries)*

### 12. Milbrandt Merlot 2017 Wahluke Slope, Columbia Valley, Washington

*Black ruby color. Aromas and flavors of baking spices, banana-coconut cream pie, leather, flamed orange, vanilla custard, and anise with a velvety, vibrant, dry-yet-fruity medium-to-full body*

### 13. Atteca Armas (Garnacha) 2019 Calatayud, Spain

*Atteca Armas 2019 is a strong red. On the nose it has notes of coconut, vanilla and smoky nuances typical of its upbringing. Rich in aromas of oak. On the palate it is structured and full-bodied.*

### 14. Ridge Vineyards 'Geyserville' (Zinfandel, Carignane, Petite Sirah) 2019 Alexander Valley, Sonoma, California

*Dark garnet red with classic Geyserville nose of ripe black cherry and plum, gravel, wintergreen, and beautiful oak spice. Deep and sensuously layered with polished tannins, river-rock minerality, and a long finish*

### 15. King Estate 'Inscription' Pinot Noir 2019 Willamette Valley, Oregon

*Intense violets and fresh wild cherries, blueberries and a spicy, bracken-like note with a stony edge*

### 16. Overture by Opus One Napa Valley, California

*Aged in French oak, this full bodied Bordeaux blend possesses generous aromas and flavors of dark fruit, spice, and cigar box with a soft, supple mid-palate. The knockout finish is vast and expansive.*
