Avalon Golf and Country Club Pool Policies

- All members and guests must sign in with the pool attendant upon arrival.
- All individuals using our pools must be members or guests of the resort. All guests must purchase a one day membership at a cost of \$10. All guests must be accompanied by an Avalon Golf and Country Club member.
- Please remember that the same guest is not permitted at the Club more than three times per year.
- If you have family visiting that will exceed the three time-maximum, please call Member Services to make special arrangements.
- Poolside lockers are available at a fee of \$25 for the season. Please see our Member Services desk.
- No swimming is permitted at the Squaw Creek Facility unless a lifeguard is on duty.
- Members 21 years and older may swim at their own risk at the Buhl Park Facility during pool hours without a lifeguard on duty.
- No children under 16 years of age are permitted in the pool or pool area without parent/adult supervision.
- A portion of the pool at Buhl Park will be sectioned off permanently for adults only.
- A portion of the pool decks at each facility will be sectioned off permanently for adults only.
- No food or beverages are permitted to be brought into the facility.
- No food or beverages are permitted inside the resort pool.
- No glass bottles or any type of glass containers are permitted in the pool area.
- No chewing gum is permitted in the pool area.
- No shouting, yelling, running or pushing.
- No diving in the shallow end at the Squaw Creek pool.
- No diving is allowed at the Resort pool or Buhl Park pool.
- Swimming attire is permitted in Largo's and Hemingway's, but cover-ups are suggested and shoes are required.
- Swimming attire is only permitted in the pool and courtyard areas at the Resort. Swim attire is not permitted in the Resort common areas.
- Members must use the West Parking Lot to enter the pool area.
- Children must be clothed in proper swimming attire at all times.
- Babies/toddlers who are not toilet trained must wear swim pants.
- Diapers must be changed and disposed of in the poolside locker room.
